

#### **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (RCIA)** (Part I)

"By the sacraments of Christian initiation, freed from the power of darkness, buried and risen with Christ, we receive the Spirit of the children of adoption and we celebrate with all the people of God the memorial of the Death and Resurrection of the Lord" (Rite of initiation Cristina, NCCB/USCC)

RCIA stands for Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, it is a communal process for the formal initiation of new members into the Catholic Church. Rite of Christian Initiation refers to adults (7 years and older) who begin a formation process with a vision of fostering a mature Christian life. It is a process of study, exploration, faith participation, and faith formation with specific liturgical rites for those seeking or exploring joining the Catholic Church.These people are unbaptized adults who want to be fully initiated into the Roman Catholic Church and/or baptized Christian adults who want full communion in the Roman Catholic Church. This program is walking in a gradual process within the community of the faithful before the unbaptized.
