The Fisher's Hook

SING, MY TONGUE

This Sunday is the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. What a great gift we have in the Eucharist, true Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord Jesus truly present to us. In honor of our Lord, I offer you the following.

In 1264, Pope Urban IV established the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Jesus. St. Thomas Aquinas wrote five Eucharistic hymns to celebrate this new feast day and honor Jesus, truly present in the Eucharist: *Lauda Sion*, *Pange Lingua*, *Sacris Solemniis*, *Verbum Supernum* and *Adoro Te Devote*. You may be familiar with them especially if you have spent time in adoration or Benediction. I am familiar with the Latin version of these, but not being a language expert, never really understood the depth and beauty of these hymns. While many of these hymns have been set to simple chant, I recently came across a modern version of Aquinas' hymns written for reflection during adoration arranged and recorded for the *Hallow* prayer app. Performed by Matt Maher, these are a beautiful mix of Latin and English lyrics with simple and powerful melodies. There are five: *Sacris Solemnis*, *Panis Angelicus*, *Adoro Te Devote*, *Pange Lingua* and *The Word Descending* (*O Salutaris*). My favorite is *Pange Lingua*, "Sing, My Tongue."

For me, the hook was this simple, beautiful, and comprehensible "cover" to an old hymn. WOW! I don't know if there was ever a clearer and more abiding statement of our faith. I fell asleep listening to this and woke up humming the tune. I think Jesus wants you to hear this and think about what He's done for us.

SING, my tongue, the Savior's glory,
of His flesh the mystery sing;
of the Blood, all price exceeding,
shed by our immortal King,
destined, for the world's redemption,
from a noble womb to spring.

Of a pure and spotless Virgin
born for us on earth below,
He, as Man, with man conversing,
stayed, the seeds of truth to sow;
then He closed in solemn order
wondrously His life of woe.

On the night of that Last Supper,
seated with His chosen band,
He the Pascal victim eating,
first fulfills the Law's command;
then as Food to His Apostles
gives Himself with His own hand.

Word-made-Flesh, the bread of nature
by His word to Flesh He turns;
wine into His Blood He changes;-
what though sense no change discerns?
Only be the heart in earnest,
faith her lesson quickly learns.

Down in adoration falling,
Lo! the sacred Host we hail;
Lo! o'er ancient forms departing,
newer rites of grace prevail;
faith for all defects supplying,
where the feeble sense fail.

To the everlasting Father,
and the Son who reigns on high,
with the Holy Ghost proceeding
forth from Each eternally,
be salvation, honor, blessing,
might and endless majesty.
Amen. Alleluia.

Este domingo es la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Qué gran don tenemos en la Eucaristía, verdadero Cuerpo y Sangre, Alma y Divinidad de nuestro Señor Jesús verdaderamente presente ante nosotros. En honor a nuestro Señor, te ofrezco lo siguiente.

En 1264, el Papa Urbano IV instituyó la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús. Santo Tomás de Aquino escribió cinco himnos eucarísticos para celebrar esta nueva fiesta y honrar a Jesús, verdaderamente presente en la Eucaristía: Lauda Sion, Pange Lingua, Sacris Solemniis, Verbum Supernum y Adoro Te Devote. Usted puede estar familiarizado con ellos, especialmente si ha pasado tiempo en adoración o bendición. Estoy familiarizada con la versión latina de estos himnos, pero como no soy una experta en idiomas, nunca entendí realmente la profundidad y la belleza de estos himnos. Si bien muchos de estos himnos se han configurado para un canto simple, recientemente encontré una versión moderna de los himnos de Aquino escritos para la reflexión durante la adoración, arreglados y grabados para la aplicación de oración Hallow. Interpretadas por Matt Maher, estas son una hermosa mezcla de letras en latín e inglés con melodías simples y poderosas. Son cinco: Sacris Solemnis, Panis Angelicus, Adoro Te Devote, Pange Lingua y The Word Descending (O Salutaris). Mi favorito es Pange Lingua, "Sing, My Tongue".
