WILL YOU STILL BE THERE?

This morning I was spending some time in prayer. Most of my prayer was about asking for help to let go of needing to be in control. That's a big thing with me. "Don't worry, Father. I got this." Like God is going to worry about whether I make a deadline... I was thinking about the Fisher's Hook for this week. Finally, I gave in. "Father, I trust you." Well, when I finished praying, I put on some music to work by. I love listening to the pop rock of the 70s. The first song that came up was John Denver's Singing Skies and Dancing Waters. Today, God hooked me.

I've heard this song many times before and loved the melody and lyrics. Listening to it again, I felt like this song was telling the story of my life. I often felt God's presence in nature. I felt Him in the beauty and majesty of mountains, forests, and lakes. I did see Him in "singing skies and dancing waters." Jesus, you were so important to me in my teens and twenties, but as I got older, "What I lost sight of was You. I didn't know." I lost my way for a long time. I lost God.

At one point not so long ago, I got a bit desperate. I knew I needed God again in my life. When I did begin to believe (a little bit) again, I did wonder, "Are You still with me?"

Where I saw and loved Him before, God joyfully reminded me, "That's where you will find me again." "I'm with you in singing skies and dancing waters, laughing children, growing old, and in the heart and in the spirit, and in the truth when it is told." Even if I fall again, God will still be there. You see, it's not about us. It's not what we do to earn this friendship with God. There is absolutely nothing we can do to deserve His love. And that's the best part. God loves us because we are His children. God is love, He is faithful, and He always keeps His promises.



Cuando terminé de rezar, puse algo música para trabajar. Me encanta escuchar el pop rock de los años 70. La primera canción que sonó fue "Singing Skies and Dancing Waters" de John Denver. Hoy, Dios me ha enganchado.

Ya había escuchado esta canción muchas veces y debo decir que me encanta la melodía y la letra. Al escucharla de nuevo, sentí que esta canción contaba la historia de mi vida. A menudo sentía la presencia de Dios en la naturaleza. Lo sentía en la belleza y la majestuosidad de las montañas, los bosques y los lagos. Le veía en "los cielos que cantan y las aguas que danzan". Jesús, fuiste tan importante para mí en mi adolescencia y en mis veinte años, pero a medida que fui

creciendo, "lo que perdí de vista fuiste Tú. No lo sabía". Perdí mi camino durante mucho tiempo. Perdí a Dios. En un momento, no hace mucho, me desesperé un poco. 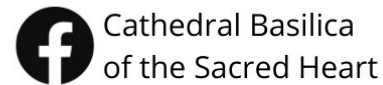
