The Fisher's Hook

I'M SORRY

Last Sunday's gospel reading (Mt. 18:15-20) begins with Jesus saying to his disciples, "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother." This has stuck with me for days now. One of the hardest things for me to do is to talk to someone who has hurt me. Maybe that's true for you, too. Often, we are tempted to stuff it down. Sometimes we ignore or avoid the person. Worst of all, sometimes we go to someone else and tell them about our painful experience. And you know, that conversation has a way of getting back to the person who hurt us. A friendship or relationship can end with a single unkind word or act. The first injury. But it also can end by the betrayal of going behind a friend's back and not telling that person directly how hurt we were. The second injury. Jesus is so right. If someone injures you, go and talk to that person - directly - just the two of you. There are plenty of media examples of the way not to do this. Accusations, an escalation of conflict, shouting, and lots of tears. I have a great example of how this could go better.

One of the bright spots of 2020 was the Apple TV+ show, Ted Lasso. During a time of some much hatred and violence, the character of Ted Lasso brought kindness and hope, consistently reinforcing the best in everyone around him. For those who have not seen this show, here's the set up. Ted Lasso is a Division II college football coach from Kansas who is hired as the head coach of AFC Richmond, a Premier League soccer team. He wasn't hired because he took his mediocre college team to a national championship, but because the team owner wanted him to fail.

The hook. Two primary characters in the show have a conflict: Roy Kent, the former team captain turned coach, who is chronically angry at everything and everyone and Trent Crimm, a sports journalist, who is following the team through a season. Roy told the team they could not talk around Trent, but this is getting in the way of their performance. Ted asks Roy to fix the issue.

The beginning of the conflict started years earlier. Roy carried a news clipping in his wallet for his whole career. It was a very harsh review of Roy's Premier League debut written by a young journalist, Trent Crimm. The reconciliation starts with Roy telling Trent how much he hurt him. "I was 17 years old. This wrecked me." Trent responds, "I thought I was being edgy, trying to make a name for myself. What I really did was look for the worst in people. I'm sorry." "It's alright. You know, it's funny, we had a lot in common back then," Roy says.



Roy carried this injury for years and Trent never knew. This interaction made an enemy a brother. Why? Well, Roy speaks honestly and calmly about the review's impact on him without accusation. Trent was given the opportunity to understand how his act affected Roy, and he apologized. Roy was heard, his feelings acknowledged, and that gave him the space to forgive Trent.

We all have moments when we need to have a hard conversation for the sake of preserving a relationship. If that person is important to you, you must. Whenever I have to do this, I remember the saying, "If you propose to speak, always ask yourself, is it true, is it necessary, is it kind?" While not attributed to Jesus, I think he would agree. Let's always move forward in truth and kindness whenever we need to forgive or be forgiven.

La lectura del evangelio del domingo pasado (Mt. 18,15-20) comienza con Jesús diciendo a sus discípulos: "Si vuestro hermano peca contra vosotros, id y repréndele estando vosotros y él solos. Si os escucha, habéis ganado". sobre tu hermano". Esto se me ha quedado grabado durante días. Una de las cosas más difíciles para mí es hablar con alguien que me ha lastimado. Tal vez eso también sea cierto para ti. A menudo, nos sentimos tentados a reprimirlo. A veces lo ignoramos o lo ignoramos. Evitar a la persona. Lo peor de todo es que a veces acudimos a otra persona y le contamos nuestra dolorosa experiencia. Y ya sabes, esa conversación tiene una manera de volver a la persona que nos lastimó. Una amistad o relación puede terminar con un solo palabra o acto desagradable. La primera herida. Pero también puede terminar con la traición de actuar a espaldas de un amigo y no decirle directamente a esa persona lo heridos que estábamos. La segunda herida. Jesús tiene mucha razón. Si alguien te lastima, ve y habla con esa persona - directamente - solo ustedes dos. Hay muchos ejemplos en los medios de comunicación sobre cómo no hacer esto. Acusaciones, escalada

del conflicto, gritos y muchas lágrimas. Tengo un gran ejemplo de cómo esto podría ir mejor.

Uno de los puntos brillantes de 2020 fue el programa de Apple TV+, Ted Lasso. Durante una época de mucho odio y violencia, el personaje de Ted Lasso trajo bondad y esperanza, reforzando constantemente lo mejor de todos los que lo rodeaban. Para aquellos que no han visto este programa, aquí está la configuración. Ted Lasso es un entrenador de fútbol universitario de la División II de Kansas que es contratado como entrenador en jefe del AFC Richmond, un equipo de fútbol de la Premier League. No lo contrataron porque llevó a su mediocre equipo universitario a un campeonato nacional, sino porque el dueño del equipo quería que fracasara.

El gancho. Dos personajes principales del programa tienen un conflicto: Roy Kent, el ex capitán del equipo convertido en entrenador, que está crónicamente enojado con todo y con todos, y Trent Crimm, un periodista deportivo, que sigue al equipo durante una temporada. Roy le dijo al equipo que no podían hablar con Trent, pero esto se interpone en su desempeño. Ted le pide a Roy que solucione el problema.

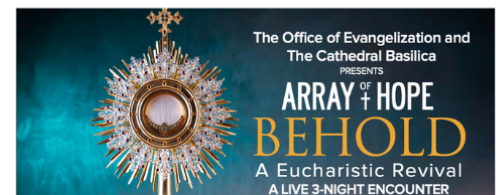
El inicio del conflicto comenzó años antes. Roy llevó un recorte de noticias en su billetera durante toda su carrera. Fue una reseña muy dura del debut de Roy en la Premier League escrita por un joven periodista, Trent Crimm. La reconciliación comienza cuando Roy le dice a Trent cuánto lo lastimó. "Yo tenía 17 años. Esto me destrozó". Trent responde: "Pensé que estaba poniéndome nervioso al intentar hacerme un nombre. Lo que realmente hice fue buscar lo

peor de las personas. Lo lamento." "Esta bien. Sabes, es curioso, teníamos mucho en común en aquel entonces", dice Roy. Puedes ver esto en:



Roy cargó con esta lesión durante años y Trent nunca lo supo. Esta interacción convirtió a un enemigo en un hermano. ¿Por qué? Bueno, Roy habla con honestidad y calma sobre el impacto que la reseña tuvo en él, sin acusaciones. A Trent se le dio la oportunidad de comprender cómo su acto afectó a Roy y se disculpó. Roy fue escuchado, sus sentimientos reconocidos y eso le dio el espacio para perdonar a Trent.

Todos tenemos momentos en los que necesitamos tener una conversación difícil para preservar una relación. Si esa persona es importante para ti, debes hacerlo. Siempre que tengo que hacer esto, recuerdo el dicho: "Si te propones hablar, pregúntate siempre: ¿es verdad, es necesario, es amable?" Si bien no se atribuye a Jesús, creo que estaría de acuerdo. Avancemos siempre en verdad y bondad. siempre que necesitemos perdonar o ser perdonados
