

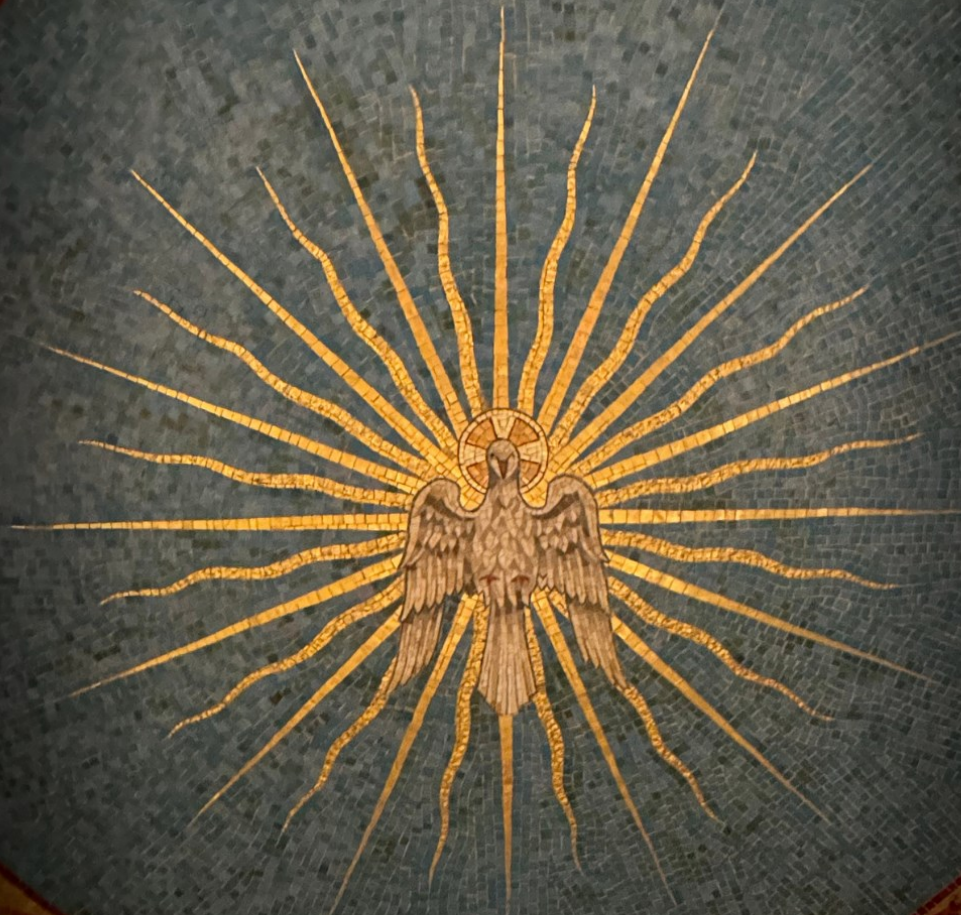

The Fisher's Hook

FOR WHERE YOUR TREASURE IS, THERE YOUR HEART WILL BE ALSO.

I was watching *The Hobbit: Battle of Five Armies* a few days ago. It's funny. I've watched this movie many times, but never really "saw" this one scene. A little background. The *Hobbit* was written by J.R.R. Tolkien, as a prequel to *The Lord of the Rings*, the sweeping tale of good over evil. In *The Hobbit*, we are introduced to the hobbits who are a simple people interested in simple pleasures and a quiet life. While small in stature, their loyalty, courage, and sheer goodness outshine the qualities of the bigger people: the Men, Elves, and Dwarves. The protagonist is Bilbo Baggins who leaves his quiet life in the Shire to go on an adventure in the company of 12 dwarves led by Thorin Oakenshield and Gandalf, the wizard, to win back the Dwarf kingdom of the Lonely Mountain and its treasure from Smaug, the dragon. They succeed in their quest, of course, and that is when the real trouble began. The enemies they fought or escaped on their journey were outside threats that could be confronted directly. The enemies that emerged later came from Thorin's heart. Even with unimaginable

wealth, he desired one thing above all, the Arkenstone. He would not be satisfied until it was found. He was so consumed by the thought of it, that lost sight of who he was, who his friends were, and why he began the quest. All Thorin's noble qualities were replaced by base greed, hunger, distrust, and suspicion. Bilbo and the others saw what was happening to Thorin. As it turns out, Bilbo had already found the Arkenstone but kept it secret, worried that if Thorin possessed it, everything would be worse.

Here's the hook. Bilbo is sitting alone in the dark when Thorin approaches him and demands, "What is that? In your hand." Bilbo says, "It's nothing." At this moment, I was sure Bilbo had been holding the Arkenstone in his hand. Thorin says, "Show me." Bilbo opens his hand and reveals an acorn. He tells Thorin that he picked it up on the way to the mountain. "You carried it all this way?" Bilbo responds, "I'm going to plant it in my garden." Thorin says, "Poor prize to take back to the Shire." Bilbo responds, "One day it'll grow and every time I look at it, I'll remember. I'll remember everything that happened, the good, the bad, and how lucky I am to have made it home."



When I watched this scene, I immediately thought about

Jesus telling his disciples not to focus on accumulating wealth here on earth but to seek to store up treasures in heaven. "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Luke 12:34). All Bilbo's treasures, his deepest desires, were attached to his home, and his heart was in the Shire. What he valued most was what the simple goodness of his heart yearned for. I wonder which character I am more like. Am I like Thorin, so consumed with what I have in the here and now, not even caring that these things will not last or am I like Bilbo, content with the seeds I plant here believing they will grow and produce heavenly treasures that can never be destroyed or taken from me? It's a good question. Where is your treasure, where is your heart?

El Anzuelo del Pescador

PORQUE DONDE ESTÉ VUESTRO TESORO, ALLÍ ESTARÁ TAMBIÉN VUESTRO CORAZÓN.

Estuve viendo El Hobbit: La Batalla de los Cinco Ejércitos hace unos días. Es gracioso. He visto esta película muchas veces, pero nunca "vi" realmente esta escena. Un poco de historia. El Hobbit fue escrito por J.R.R. Tolkien, como precuela de El Señor de los Anillos, la amplia historia del bien sobre el mal. En El Hobbit, nos presentan a los hobbits, que son un pueblo sencillo interesado en los placeres sencillos y una vida tranquila. Aunque son de pequeña estatura, su lealtad, coraje y pura bondad eclipsan las cualidades de las personas más grandes: los hombres, los elfos y los enanos. El protagonista es Bilbo Bolsón que deja su vida tranquila en la Comarca para emprender una aventura en compañía de 12 enanos liderados por Thorin Escudo de Roble y Gandalf, el mago, para recuperar el reino enano de la Montaña Solitaria y su tesoro de manos de Smaug, el dragón. Por supuesto, tienen éxito en su búsqueda, y fue entonces cuando comenzaron los verdaderos problemas. Los enemigos con los que lucharon o escaparon en su viaje eran amenazas externas a las que

podían enfrentarse directamente. Los enemigos que surgieron después vinieron del corazón de Thorin. Incluso con una riqueza inimaginable, deseaba una cosa por encima de todo: la Piedra del Arken. No estaría satisfecho hasta que lo encontraran. Estaba tan consumido por la idea que perdió de vista quién era él, quiénes eran sus amigos y por qué comenzó la búsqueda. Todas las nobles cualidades de Thorin fueron reemplazadas por la avaricia, el hambre, la desconfianza y la sospecha. Bilbo y los demás vieron lo que le estaba pasando a Thorin. Resulta que Bilbo ya había encontrado la Piedra del Arca, pero la mantuvo en secreto, preocupado de que si Thorin la poseyera, todo sería peor. Aquí está el gancho. Bilbo está sentado solo en la oscuridad cuando Thorin se le acerca y le pregunta: "¿Qué es eso? En tu mano." Bilbo dice: "No es nada". En ese momento, estaba seguro de que Bilbo había estado sosteniendo la Piedra del Arca en su mano. Thorin dice: "Muéstramelo". Bilbo abre la mano y revela una bellota. Le dice a Thorin que lo recogió camino a la montaña. "¿Lo llevaste hasta aquí?" Bilbo responde: "Voy a plantarlo en mi jardín". Thorin dice: "Poco premio para llevarlo a la Comarca". Bilbo responde: "Un día crecerá y cada vez que lo mire lo recordaré. Recordaré todo lo que pasó, lo bueno, lo malo y la suerte que tengo de haber llegado a casa". Cuando vi esta escena, inmediatamente pensé en Jesús diciéndoles a sus discípulos que no se concentraran en acumular

riquezas aquí en la tierra sino que buscaran acumular tesoros en el cielo. "Porque donde esté vuestro tesoro, allí estará también vuestro corazón" (Lucas 12:34). Todos los tesoros de Bilbo, sus deseos más profundos, estaban unidos a su hogar y su corazón estaba en la Comarca. Lo que más valoraba era lo que anhelaba la sencilla bondad de su corazón. Me pregunto a qué personaje me parezco más. ¿Soy como Thorin, tan consumido por lo que tengo aquí y ahora, sin siquiera preocuparme de que estas cosas no duren, o soy como Bilbo, contento con las semillas que planto aquí creyendo que crecerán y producirán tesoros celestiales que nunca podrán llegar? ¿Será destruido o quitado de mí? Es una buena pregunta. ¿Dónde está tu tesoro, dónde está tu corazón?
