The Fisher's Hook

WE SERVE, BUT WE ARE NOT SERVANTS

To be honest, I am not a big fan of romcoms. But, of course, while flipping through TV channels, I settled into watching the end of *Maid in Manhattan*. The movie is about a hotel housekeeper and a rising politician who fall in love. The problem is that the politician thinks that the young woman is from high society. You know, someone from his socio-economic class. Fun fact: The film is loosely based on a true story. In 1959, Steven Clark Rockefeller, son of New York Governor Nelson Rockefeller, married Anne-Marie Rasmussen, a maid who had worked at his family's Manhattan hotel.

When her true identity is revealed, there are lots of accusations, and, in the end, she is fired from her job. When she goes to the security desk to drop off her keys and id card, the hotel manager approaches her. She says, "Don't tell me they fired you over this, too." And he responds. "I made a decision a moment ago that was long overdue. Sometimes we're forced into directions that we ought to have found for ourselves."

Here comes the hook. He continues, "To serve people takes



dignity and intelligence. But remember, they're only people with money. Although we serve them, we are not their servants." Jesus showed us by example what we should be for one another. Remember, after he washed his disciples' feet, he said to them "Do you understand what I have done for you?" he asked them. "You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am. Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you" (John 13:12-15). Jesus came to serve and not to be served.

In this age, service gets a bad rap. Our culture tells us we should strive to be at the top. So many people today expect others to bend toward their needs. And we are so unhappy. I think we can find joy and deep satisfaction by putting others first, reaching out and helping someone, and focusing outward. Our self-focus and constant upward comparisons do not lift us up, but often send us into a spiral of sadness, anxiety, and depression. Jesus came to serve and that is our calling, too. To serve does indeed take dignity and intelligence. We are not less for serving, we are better for it. It is also worth remembering. "Although we serve them, we are not their servants." I would change this a little to, "we should

not be servile." This means that we serve by choice, purposefully and with dignity. True service is based in strength, not in weakness or feeling victimized. Jesus told us, if someone asks you for your cloak, give them your tunic as well. If someone takes our "cloak," we may feel like a victim, but when we freely give our "tunic" as well, we take ownership of our service. Then we can kneel next to Jesus and wash each other's feet.

El Anzuelo Del Pescador

SERVIMOS, PERO NO SOMOS SIERVOS.

Para ser sincera, no soy una gran fan de las comedias románticas. Pero, claro, mientras ojeaba los canales de televisión, me dispuse a ver el final de Maid in Manhattan. La película trata de un ama de llaves de hotel y un político en ascenso que se enamoran. El problema es que el político cree que la joven es de la alta sociedad. Ya sabes, alguien de su clase socioeconómica. Dato curioso: La película está vagamente basada en una historia real. En 1959, Steven Clark Rockefeller, hijo del gobernador de Nueva York Nelson Rockefeller, se casó con Anne-Marie Rasmussen, una camarera que había trabajado en el hotel de su familia en Manhattan.

Cuando se revela su verdadera identidad, hay muchas acusaciones y, al final, la despiden de su trabajo. Cuando va al mostrador de seguridad a dejar las llaves y el carné de identidad, el director del hotel se le acerca. Ella le dice: "No me digas que también te han despedido por esto". Y él responde. "Hace un momento he tomado una decisión que venía de lejos. A veces nos obligan a tomar direcciones que deberíamos haber encontrado por nosotros mismos".



Aquí viene el gancho. El continúa: "Para servir a la gente hace falta dignidad e inteligencia. Pero recuerda que sólo son personas con dinero. Aunque les sirvamos, no somos sus siervos".

Jesús nos mostró con su ejemplo lo que debemos ser los unos para los otros. Recordad que, después de lavar los pies a sus discípulos, les dijo: "¿Comprendéis lo que he hecho por vosotros?", les preguntó. "Me llamáis Maestro y Señor, y con razón, porque eso es lo que soy. Ahora que yo, vuestro Señor y Maestro, os he lavado los pies, también vosotros debéis lavaros los pies los unos a los otros. Os he dado ejemplo para que hagáis como yo he hecho con vosotros" (Juan 13, 12-15). Jesús vino a servir y no a ser servido

En esta época, el servicio tiene mala fama. Nuestra cultura nos dice que debemos esforzarnos por estar en lo más alto. Tanta gente espera hoy que los demás se plieguen a sus necesidades. Y somos tan infelices. Creo que podemos encontrar alegría y profunda satisfacción poniendo a los demás en primer lugar, tendiendo la mano y ayudando a alguien, y centrándonos en el exterior. Nuestro enfoque en nosotros mismos y nuestras constantes comparaciones hacia arriba no nos elevan, sino que a menudo nos envían a una espiral de tristeza, ansiedad y depresión. Jesús vino a servir y ésa es también nuestra vocación. Servir requiere dignidad e inteligencia. No somos menos por servir, somos mejores por ello. También vale la pena

recordarlo. "Aunque les servimos, no somos sus siervos". Yo lo cambiaría un poco por "no debemos ser serviles". Esto significa que servimos por elección, con determinación y dignidad. El verdadero servicio se basa en la fortaleza, no en la debilidad ni en sentirse víctima. Jesús nos dijo, si alguien te pide tu capa, dale también tu túnica. Si alguien nos quita nuestra "capa", podemos sentirnos víctimas, pero cuando damos libremente también nuestra "túnica", nos apropiamos de nuestro servicio. Entonces podemos arrodillarnos junto a Jesús y lavarnos los pies unos a otros.
